1. All attendees to the reunion must sign the statement of general policies and the personal liability waiver printed below.
2. Camp Dixie will not be held responsible for personal injury or illness. Report all injuries to the camp First Aid personnel and camp director.
3. Each attendee is responsible for his/her own personal safety and medical care.
4. Please adhere to designated arrival times. Please arrange to arrive no earlier than 5pm on Friday. Departure time on Sunday is 11:30 am.
5. There is NO SMOKING anywhere at Camp Dixie. Camp Dixie is a Smoke Free Facility.
6. No pets please. This includes dogs, cats, etc.
7. Our waterfront areas are off limits unless Camp Dixie Lifeguards are on duty. No Free Swim. These rules are for each attendee's safety!
8. Disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated and anyone causing difficulties will be asked to leave the premises. There are no refunds issued for dismissal.
9. No alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs, fireworks, firearms or pets.
10. Parking areas are indicated at camp. Please DO NOT park on the grassy areas. Do not block drive.
11. Please respect the natural environment of camp.
12. Do not sit on rails, run on wooden walkway, or hang on wooden overhead beams.
13. Do not go in buildings marked "Staff Only".
14. Do not write or draw on any Camp property.

Camp Dixie Waiver

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in the Camp Dixie Centennial Celebration, August 1 – 3, 2014 (hereinafter 'the Activity'), I, for myself, and my immediate family participating in the activity, my heirs, personal representatives or assignees, do hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue or hold in any way responsible, Camp Dixie, LLC, its owners, directors, officers, employees, and agents from liability from any and all claims arising during the course of the Activity. The waiver of liability includes but is not limited to potential claims of negligence against Camp Dixie, LLC, its owners, directors, officers, employees and agents, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and/or property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in the Activity. The term 'Activity' as used to describe the events of the Camp Dixie Centennial Celebration is defined to include all events, activities, free time, residential time, and all time spent on or around the property of the Camp Dixie during the course of the 2014 Centennial Celebration whether or not this time is part of an organized reunion event.

Assumption of Risks:

Participation in the Activity carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but may include the following: 1) minor injuries (e.g. scratches, bruises, and sprains) 2) major injuries (e.g. eye injury or loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks, and concussions) and 3) catastrophic injuries (e.g. paralysis or death).

Indemnification and Hold Harmless:

I also agree to Indemnify and Hold Camp Dixie, LLC Harmless from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees brought as a result of my involvement in the Activity and to reimburse them for any such expenses incurred.

Severability:

The undersigned further expressly agrees that the foregoing waiver and assumption of risks agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of Georgia and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Acknowledgement of Understanding:

I have read this waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, fully understand its terms, and understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue. I acknowledge that I am signing the agreement freely and voluntarily, and intend by my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law. I understand that failure to sign this document will disqualify me from participation in the Activity and I will not be permitted on or around camp grounds during the entirety of the Activity.
